The scene of all this excitement was Pricedale, Pa. When he was old enough, Andy enrolled at the local grammar school and from there graduated into high school.

Having had a foretaste of work even if only as a grocery boy aftor school, he left high school to be an assistant breadwinner in the family, Since work wasn't too plentiful, Andy left Pa., and wound up in Passaic where he got work at Manhattan Rubber. The following year the balance of the Tyukody family made their entry into the same community. From the Rubber mill, Andy went to work at a few other places until finally in 1937, he returned to Manhattan Rubber, where he is still employed presently as a truck driver.

Being a firm believer in sharing his wealth, Andy finally convinced Emma Galambos that as far as he was concerned she was the one for him. They promised their marital fidelity to one another at Holy Cross Church in Iselin, Fa., on Sept. 28, 1940. They have two charming children, Carolyn,9, and Andrew,6. Recently they moved to 47 Bergen Ave., Clifton, which they now call home.

Andy was quite an active bowler until four years ago, when a broken leg proved to be a little too much for him.
